

# A DECLARATION

By The Representative Of  
Free AMERICANS

When in the course of human Events it becomes necessary for free Americans to dissolve the political bands which connected us with another, and to assume among the Powers of the Earth, the separate and equal Station to which the Laws of Nature entitle them, a decent Respect to the Opinions of Mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the Separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are equal under the law and that they are entitled to certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty, and Private Property. That to secure these Rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just Powers from the Consent of the Governed, that whenever Form of Government becomes destructive of these Ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute a new Supreme Court, laying its foundation on such Principles, and organizing its Powers in such Form as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety liberty and protection of their private property.

Mankind are more disposed to suffer, while Evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the Forms to which they are accustomed. But when a long Train of Abuses and Usurpations, pursuing invariably the same Object, evinces a Design to reduce them under absolute Depotism, it is their right , it is their Duty, to throw off such a Court, and to provide new Guards for their future Security. Such has been the patient Sufferance of these United States; and such is now the Necessity which constrains them to alter their former Systems of Courts. The History of the present Supreme Court is a History of repeated Injuries and Usurpations, all having in direct Object the Establishment of an absolute Tyranny over our states. To prove this, let Facts be submitted to a candid World.

The Court has refused his Assent to the Constitution, the most wholesome and necessary for the public good.

The Court has obstructed the Administration of Justice, by refusing to consistently protect private property from the depredations of governments, large and small that claim the right of eminent domain to mean that what constitutes the public good is the highest tax obtainable.

The Court has combined with others to subject us to a Jurisdiction foreign to our Constitution, and unacknowledged by our Laws, increasingly turned to

foreign court decisions and protocols for the basis of decisions that impinge on the sovereignty of The United States.

The Court has used specious arguments to strike down the states laws against the practice of sodomy, and thereby has opened the doors to same sex marriages opposed by a majority of our citizens.

The Court has chosen to support Affirmative Action on the basis that the Program as Practiced by the University of Michigan is justified by the specious need for diversity.

The Court has, based on legal briefs Abroad, decided that Juveniles under 18 are not to be subject to Capital Punishment for the acts of Murder.

Finally, the Court has, by its repeated and blatant transgressions of specific provisions of the Constitution, shown its contempt for good behavior, the penultimate stipulation for retention of office.

In every stage of these Oppressions we have Petitioned for Redress in the most humble terms: Our repeated Petitions have been answered only by repeated Injury. We have appealed to their native Justice and Magnanimity, and we have conjured the Court by Ties of our common Kindred to disavow these Usurpations, which, would inevitably interrupt our Connections and Correspondence. The Court has been deaf to the Voice of Justice and of Consanguinity. We must therefore, acquiesce in the Necessity, which denounces our Separation, and the Court, as we hold the rest of Mankind, Enemies in War, in Peace, Friends.

We, therefore, As Free Americans, appealing to the Supreme Judge of the World for the Rectitude of our Intentions, do, in the Name and by Authority of the good People of America solemnly Publish and Declare, That all Americans are, and of Right ought to be, truly FREE AND INDEPENDENT; that we are absolved from all Allegiance to the Supreme Court, as now constituted, and that all political Connection between them and the Court is and ought to be totally dissolved; and that as FREE AND INDEPENDENT Americans, they have full Power to constitute the Supreme Court as they see fit. And for the support of this Declaration, with a firm Reliance on the Protection of divine Providence we mutually pledge to each other our Lives, our Fortunes, and our scared Honor.
